# Vaccinations

Dogs and puppies are required to be vaccinated against rabies as per NC State law. Vaccinations against distemper, parvovirus, hepatitis, parainfluenza and bordatella should be administered on the schedule recommended by your veterinarian. Please mail a copy of proof of vaccination or titer results or bring them to the first class. No puppy or dog will be allowed in class with out their vaccination record.

## Class Descriptions

### Puppy Kindergarten

For puppies between the ages of 8 weeks and 18 weeks at the time the class begins.

Get your new puppy off to a great start in life. The class will focus on gradual, positive socialization of your pup to people and other puppies. You will learn management skills to prevent future behavior problems. Your puppy will learn the foundation skills of attention, sit, down, come, targeting and loose leash walking.

### Basic Family Dog

Your dog can learn to be a well-behaved family member. Your dogs will learn basic obedience skills such as attention, sit, down, come, stay, loose leash walking, leave it. You will learn to manage your dog and apply the obedience skills to everyday situations.

### Intermediate Family Dog

Develop your partnership with your dog. This class will help you and your dog strengthen basic obedience skills and to perform them around distractions. The focus will be on team-building, come, stay and heeling.

### Advanced Family Dog

Prepares you and your dog to take the Canine Good Citizen test. It combines obedience skills with application to real life such as greeting strangers, sitting politely for petting, meeting other dogs and working around distractions. Participants will have an opportunity to take the CGC test at the end of the class.

Paw in Hand is located in northern Chatham County, near Cole Park Plaza, next to Max's Dog Wash.

## From Chapel Hill:

- Take 15-501 S towards Chatham County.
- Go through the intersection at Old Lystra Road and continue for 0.2 mile.
- Make a left immediately before the Burger King/Eagles Plaza gas station (there is a turn lane but no street sign).
- Paw in Hand Dog Training is on the right behind the Burger King and before the Chatham Recycling Center.

## From Carrboro:

- Take Smith Level Rd south towards Chatham County.
- At the end of Smith Level make a right onto 15-501 S.
- Go 0.9 mile and make a left immediately before the Burger King/Eagles Plaza gas station (there is a turn lane but no street sign).
- Paw in Hand Dog Training is on the right behind the Burger King and before the Chatham Recycling Center.

## From Pittsboro:

- Take 15-501 N towards Northern Chatham.
- Pass Mann's Chapel Rd and go another 0.2 miles.
- Make a right immediately after the Burger King/Eagles Plaza gas station.
- Paw in Hand Dog Training is on the right behind the Burger King and before the Chatham Recycling Center.
